<p>SPSA Review and Feedback</p>	<p>Lecy reviewed key components and reasons for a SPSA. Murtagh discussed ELD training, TOSA support, parent engagement, and student celebrations as part of the SPSA. SSC gave feedback about tutoring, art, team building, professional development,</p>
