- ☐ We held a Capturing Kids' Hearts professional development opportunity for classified and certificated staff. This training helps staff learn how to build relationships with students and colleagues, create a safe environment for learning, and develop self-managing classrooms.
- ☐ Throughout July subject-level PLC (Professional Learning Community) teams from WHS and WIS met at GCOE to get a head start on the year and develop a scope and sequence, or roadmap, which outlines what topics will be taught and when and how they'll build on each other throughout the year.
- ☐ August 4th professional development focused on PLC time for the teachers to continue the work they have done to identify essential standards and build common formative assessments.
- ☐ Eloise Lengyel and I were able to attend a NextGen Personal Finance curriculum training at Chico State. She will be teaching Personal Finance at Willows High School this year.

- ☐ The science department at Willows High School will be piloting McGraw Hill's Inspire Science curriculum this year for Ag Earth, Ag Chemistry, and Ag Biology.
- ☐ 6th-8th grade will be piloting two math curricula this fall: Cengage's California Math and You and Amplify Desmos Math.
- ☐ TK-5th grade will be piloting two math curricula this year: HMH's Into Math in the fall and Amplify Desmos Math in the spring.
