This contract is for RO Health, LLC, which provides one Registered Behavior Technician that works with applied behavior analysis to implement plans, and one Board Certified Behavior Analyst, that designs, implements, and evaluates behavior-analytic interventions to improve problematic behaviors. The Registered Behavior Technician and Board Certified Behavior Analyst provide support at each site's Special Education program. Our behavioral caseloads exceeded by a 1.00 FTE, which requires an additional BCBA to meet and implement IEP minutes. Previously approved contract was for \$57,000.00, and the new amended total is \$110,400.00, a net increase of \$53,400.00.

This is the second reading of the Mobile Communication Devices Board Policy 5131.8. Policy 5131.8 is a new policy that reflects the AB 3216 which requires the Governing Board to, by July 1, 2026, develop, adopt, and update every five years a policy to limit or prohibit student use of smartphones while at a school site or under the supervision and control of district employee(s). ## 9.15 Education Enhancement Reserve Joint Powers Agreement Between Mountain View Los Altos High School District and the Shoreline Regional Park Community

The 2025 Education Enhancement Reserve Joint Powers Agreement (EER JPA) is a long-term partnership between the Shoreline Regional Park Community, Mountain View Whisman School District and the Mountain View Los Altos Union High School District. Its purpose is to provide ongoing, sustainable funding that supports the educational and technological capacity of students who reside in and serve the workforce needs of the Shoreline area. This agreement builds upon decades of collaboration and previous EER agreements. Beginning in fiscal year 2025–26, the agreement outlines a structured payment system from the Shoreline Community to the school districts, including a baseline annual payment adjusted for property tax growth and an additional payment tied specifically to new residential development in the Shoreline area. This updated agreement remains in effect through June 30, 2035, with provisions for potential extension.
