

Token Board Explanation


- Allow child to pick reinforcer or desired choice off of choice board.
- Each time child shows the desired behavior(s), allow child to earn token on the token board.
Example; each time child gets off iPad within one minute of being asked s/he earns a token.
- When the token board is full, give the child the identified reinforcer and reset board for use again.
- It is important to note that the more frequent a behavior, the more frequent the positive reinforcement should be.




