 Essentials or to make up tests from the grading period to meet athletic eligibility requirements.
 - Students will become ineligible for participation on their team beginning Friday, October 24, 2025, if they have 3+ NC/NM or a GPA below 2.0 for the grading period.
 - Students must inform their teachers that a grade change for athletic purposes is needed.
