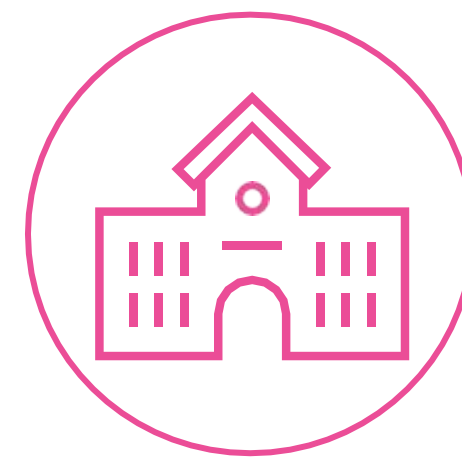

What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual enrollment refers to college courses taken by high school students during their high school career.

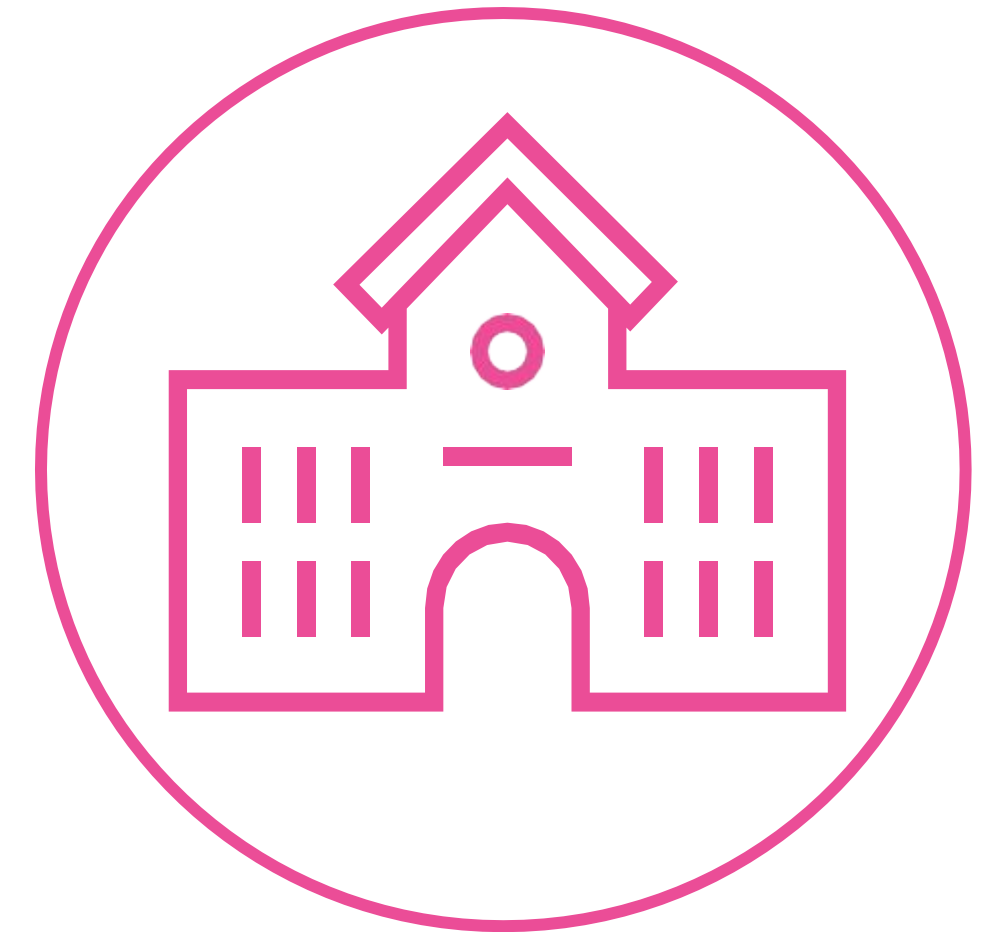

Community college courses are taught on the high school campus.

- High school instructor receives dual appointment with the CCC to teach the college course
- Course follows college curriculum
- Student sits in class with fellow high school peers
- **College issues transcript with credits and grades for all college coursework**

Using College Courses to Meet A-G requirements

Guidelines

- ✓ College must be accredited by one of the seven former regional accrediting agencies
- ✓ Course must be UC-transferable*
- ✓ Course must be at least 3 semester/4 quarter units in value (each)
- ✓ Course must clearly fall within an A-G subject area
- ✓ Course must be taken for a letter grade
- ✓ Letter grade of C or better (not C-) must be earned

	A-G Requirement
History/Social Science: AREA A	A. 2 years required
English: AREA B	B. 4 years required
Mathematics: AREA C	C. 3 years required (through IM3) ✓ 4 years recommended
Science: AREA D	D. 2 years required ✓ 3 years recommended
Language Other than English (LOTE): AREA E	E. 2 years required ✓ 3 years recommended
Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA): AREA F	F. 1 year required
Electives: AREA G	G. 1 year additional a-g course required
Physical Education	
Minimum grade for credit	“C-” Grade

Always have a copy of your transcript next to you when completing the Academic History section of your college applications.

- Your self-reported Academic History must exactly match the official transcripts you will send to the ONE school where you submit your Statement of Intent to Register (SIR).

General Application Reminders

- Add all A-G high school coursework, regardless of the grade in your high school Academic History.
 - You will not find PE, IPS, Class TA, or Dual Enrollment classes in the PGHS dropdown menu.
- If you took IM1 or a LOTE in middle school, ensure you add it in the 7th & 8th grade section.
- If you attended any other high school than PGHS, you must add that school in your Academic History.
 - This includes taking one elective class at Silicon Valley High School such as Spanish.
 - Be sure to get a copy of your other school's transcript so you can enter the correct letter grades.
- **If you cannot find a class or are confused where to add a class, ALWAYS ASK FOR ASSISTANCE BEFORE YOU SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION.**
- APPLES TO APPS workshops are available Tuesday and Wednesday from 2:00-3:00 PM for the entire month of October and November in the PGHS College and Career Center.

Reporting Dual Enrollment Courses on the UC Application

1

College courses must be reported in the “Colleges attended” section of the Academic History

2

The UC application is linked to [ASSIST.org](https://assist.org). Students select courses from a drop-down menu.

3

Students must select the subject area (A-G) and discipline for each course.

4

Students must report the grade that appears on the college transcript.

5

Courses that do not meet A-G can be reported as “other coursework” in the Activities & Awards section



Dual enrollment courses should not be reported as both high school and college courses.

Dual Enrollment and the Transcript

- **ALL college courses MUST be reported, regardless of the grade.**
- Dual enrollment courses listed on high school transcripts should be clearly marked as college/dual enrollment.
 - PGHS CCAP MPC classes on the PGHS transcript are labeled with a DE tag.
- Admitted DE students are required to submit both official high school and community college transcripts with their SIR.
