School Health Index- Sharon Glosson, Executive Director for School Nutrition

The School Health Index is a tool developed by the CDC and completed by a team on each of our campuses. These teams are chosen from different departments on the campus. This survey is a very lengthy survey and is only completed every two years. Our campuses were given the survey in October and asked to complete the survey by January.

Throughout the survey there is guidance regarding the levels 0-3, 0 being not in place and 3 being fully in place. There are also examples to help guide the teams to select their correct rating. The data that is given to the SHAC is average data for the entire district. It is not specific to each school. We want to work toward an overall goal and not focus on a specific school.

As a committee, we would like for you to review these results and come up with a recommendation for the Executive Staff and Board of Trustees. With that said, we would also like to make realistic recommendations. Rachel and I will review the recommendations and may offer some tweaks to the recommendation to make it plausible and achievable which will give the recommendation more of a chance to be passed by the Board. The results of this review will be further scrutinized to determine which recommendations will be sent to KSHAC for their feedback. You will finalize your recommendations utilizing their feedback on May 5, 2015.
