- You must have a minimum **2.0 GPA and no Fs** to be in Leadership class
- You must have a fair understanding of the commitment for which you are signing up for

- You will be asked a series of questions by the current Executive Council including, but not limited to...
 - Your specific plans for your time in Leadership
 - Your qualifications to be considered for admission to the program
 - **You will be contacted by the ASB Vice President with an interview time**
 - It is a good idea to wear professional attire for your interview
- If chosen to join the **Leadership class** for the 26-27 school year
 - This will dictate some schedule options
