ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

The Native American Education Program supports the unique cultural, language, and educational needs of American Indian and Alaska Native students, including preschool children. The program provides opportunities and resources that promote academic success while honoring culture and community.

The program is funded through the Title VI Indian Education Formula Grant from the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Indian Education.

How Do I Qualify?

Eligibility is determined through the ED 506 Form, which documents a student's eligibility for the Native American Education Program. Families complete the form by providing information about the student's, parent's, or grandparent's tribal affiliation.

Once completed, the form helps the district identify eligible students and connect families with program services, resources, and opportunities.

- Culturally enriching programs and family events that celebrate culture, community, and connection.
- Family leadership opportunities through the Native American Parent Advisory Committee (NAPAC), including opportunities to provide input and help guide the Native American Education Program.
