We are back into the swing of things. It has been a challenge starting off the year with new schedules, serving times and arranging staff to fit these changes. I am happy to report that the Administration at all sites have been very helpful and patient with all the changes we have had to make in these first few weeks. I am very appreciative for the willingness to pivot and try new things when the plan was less than desirable for the staff and students.

ADP – Average daily participation (% of students enrolled who participated)

93.8% attendance factor used for calculations

Murdock served 3855 breakfasts & 5319 Lunches

MES- Breakfast- AVG 241 students or 55.26% of enrollment - -

Lunch- AVG 332 students or 76.26 % of enrollment -

WIS served 3458 breakfasts & 4633 Lunches

WIS Breakfast- AVG 216 students or 53.20% of enrollment -

Lunch- AVG 279 students or 68.7 % of enrollment -

WHS served 2396 breakfasts & 2280 Lunches

WHS Breakfast- AVG 150 students or 35.6 % of enrollment –

This number worries me. This is 50+ students less per day of what we averaged last year.

(I believe this is due to cutting second chance by 12 minutes)

Lunch- AVG 142 students or 33.83% of enrollment

WCHS served 64 breakfasts & 95 Lunches

WCHS Breakfast- AVG 4 students or 50% of enrollment

Lunch- AVG 6 students or 74.17% of enrollment
