POSITION SUMMARY:

Under general supervision, performs skilled work in the installation, repair and maintenance of heating, ventilation and boiler equipment. Performs repair work on school buildings and other equipment as assigned.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Inspects, repairs, maintains and services air conditioning, refrigeration, ventilation and heating equipment, including large walk-in cool boxes and freeze boxes, roof and window air conditioners, fans, boilers and heaters.

Assists other maintenance personnel by performing unskilled or semiskilled duties in all types of maintenance and custodial functions.

Replaces valves, fans, motors, gaskets, filters and belts.

Makes plumbing and electrical repairs.

Programs, repairs and replaces thermostats.

Adjusts air flow vents and dampers.

Inspects, disassembles, repairs and maintains hot water and forced air heating and ventilation equipment.

Lubricates and maintains pumps, motors and bearings.

Performs minor brazing and welding.

Makes estimates of labor and material costs for jobs.

Cares for and stores tools and provides for security of tools, materials and equipment.

Operates District's vehicles.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES (NONESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS):

Other related duties as assigned.
