REASON FOR TAKING AN ONLINE CLASS

ON-CAMPUS ONLINE COURSE AGREEMENT

- I understand that a student must have a 2.0 minimum overall GPA in order to enroll in an **on-campus** online course.
- I understand that the course(s) is taught completely online.
- I understand that the course(s) is taught by an online teacher, not taught by a Hartland High School staff member.
- I understand that a student cannot be successful in the course(s) unless they regularly log into the course(s) through the online provider.
- I understand that it is recommended that a student plan to spend a minimum of 1 hour per day per course on their online course(s).
- I understand that the student is responsible to communicate with their mentor on a regular basis as determined by the mentor & student.

PLEASE NOTE:

- It is the **parent's responsibility** to monitor the student's progress in their online course.
- Final grade for the course will not be posted until the end of the semester.

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REASONS WHY STUDENTS CAN BE DENIED

The district can deny a student's request to enroll in an online course for the following reasons:

1. The student has previously gained the credits provided from the completion of the online course.
2. The online course is not capable of generating academic credit.
3. The online course is inconsistent with the remaining graduation requirements or career interests of the student.
4. The student does not possess the prerequisite knowledge and skills to be successful in the online course or has demonstrated failure in previous online course.
5. The online course is of insufficient quality or rigor. The following courses are not approved by HHS due to insufficient quality or rigor:
 - Career Planning
 - Careers – Find Your Future
 - Employability Skills
 - Leadership Skills
 - Personal Fitness
 - Reading for College Success
 - Social Media
 - Study Skills

COURSE FAILURE AND CREDIT RECOVERY

- Students who have failed an online course will not be allowed to take an online course in the future.
- A student that has failed an online course may repeat the course at HHS or through HHS Credit Recovery or through HCS Summer School.
