I. OPEN SESSION

This two-day Board Workshop is part of a collaborative, community-informed process to develop an EDUHSD Portrait of a Graduate. The session will bring together trustees, district leaders, educators, students, parents, and community partners to define the skills, knowledge, and qualities every EDUHSD graduate should possess in preparation for life after high school.

Participants will explore how work, learning, and postsecondary opportunities are evolving, examine examples from other districts, and engage in structured dialogue to draft and refine a shared vision. The workshop will also outline how this work will inform the District's 2026–2027 strategic planning process and guide future decisions related to programs, budgeting, and student outcomes.

No formal action will be taken during this workshop.
