4.1 Public Comment Regarding any item NOT on the OPEN SESSION Agenda: Members of the public addressed the Board regarding the decision to make a change at the head wrestling coach position for the 2026-2027 season.

5. RECOGNITIONS AND REPORTS:

5.1 Student of the Month Recognition: Mrs. Mathrole presented Alycia Rico as Fairview Elementary’s student of the month. Described by Mrs. Mathrole as kind, caring, and someone with a truly big heart, Alycia is a responsible and hardworking student who consistently goes above and beyond. She demonstrates incredible strength and resilience, approaching challenges with both courage and confidence.

Alycia is always willing to lend a helping hand and serves as a wonderful example for her peers each and every day.

5.2 Principal’s Report: Mrs. Mathrole shared her principal’s report with the Board. She discussed school events, site goals, and site data.

5.3 School Representative Report: Yesenia Rojo, this year’s class salutatorian, shared an update on Orland High School sports, clubs and school activities.

5.4 Classified Representative Report: Kelly Stofle, CSEA President, discussed the CSEA scholarship and upcoming negotiations.

She also recognized the work that MOT has done. Next month is classified employee week.

5.5 Certificated Representative Reports: Ann Pettit, OTA representative, gave an update on activities going on at all of the sites.

5.6 Superintendent’s Report: Superintendent Perry deferred his report.

5.7 CBO Report: Ms. Boone provided an update to the Board regarding fiscal items of note since the last meeting. She reported that the draft Glenn County SELPA allocation model reflects the district’s decision to run the Adult Transition Program beginning in 26/27. The program transfer will result in OUSD program management as well as a reduction in special education costs.

Ms. Boone announced that the District has received an additional Strong Work Force Grant to improve career readiness for Alternative Education students at North Valley. This grant was written to increase access for NV students to OHS CTE pathways.

The 26/27 state budget was discussed, including a proposed Prop 98 maneuver which withholds over \$5 Billion from flowing to school districts. Widespread opposition to this maneuver was discussed. The May Revision will be released prior to the next Board meeting and an update will be provided.

Finally, Ms. Boone reported that preliminary budget development is underway. The reality of statewide and districtwide declining enrollment was discussed. Projections show a drop of 40 students for the 26/27 year and an additional 50 students for the 27/28 year. The responsibility to budget and staff accordingly was reviewed.

6. FACILITIES:

6.1 Facilities Update: Superintendent Perry shared that next month he will be sharing an in-depth facilities report on the property the District recently purchased along with a project update.

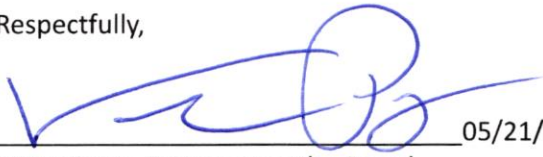
