1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Smythe Academy of Arts & Sciences used Prop 28 funding in 2023–24, 2024–25, and 2025–26 to expand arts programming and increase student access to arts courses. Through the addition of 0.6 FTE for music, the school added three sections of band to the master schedule, providing expanded music opportunities for 7th–8th grade students. An additional 0.775 FTE at the elementary level ensured that all 3rd-grade students received weekly art and music instruction throughout the entire school year. Collectively, these staffing expansions increased access to arts education for 152 students. Prop 28 funds also supported improvements to arts learning environments and enrichment opportunities, including upgrading a classroom to better function as an arts instructional space with additional storage, providing field trips and on-site arts assemblies, funding the art museum's on-campus education program, and purchasing additional arts supplies, equipment, and musical instruments.
