- Increased Reading proficiency with 2<sup>nd</sup> - 44%, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 67%, 4<sup>th</sup> - 36% and 5<sup>th</sup> - 43%.
- Increased Math proficiency in 1<sup>st</sup> grade up to 50% at or above grade level.

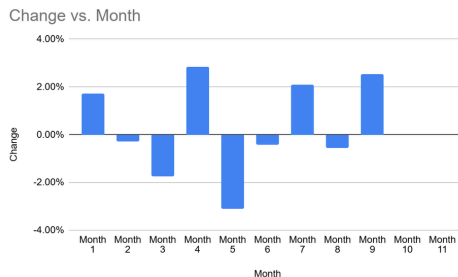
**Looking Ahead:**
