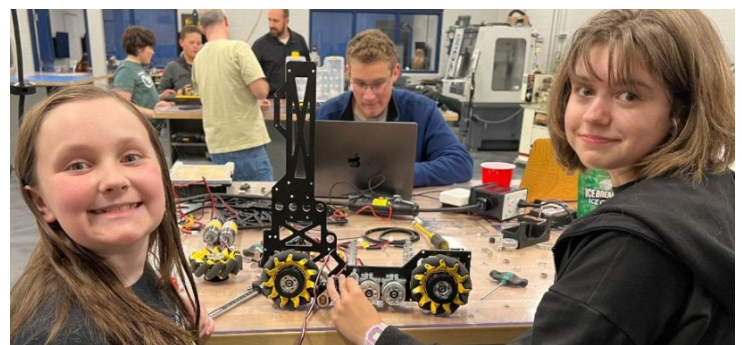
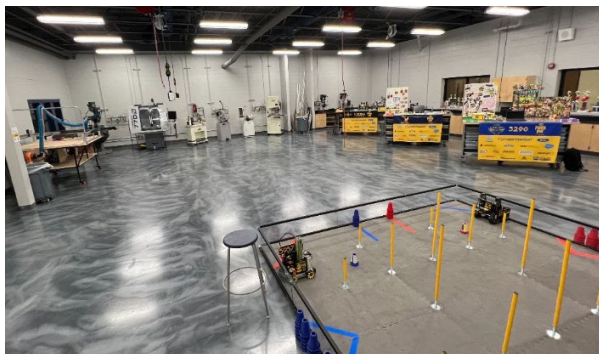

Transportation Forms

Forms for the 2026–2027 school year are now being accepted. Submit them as soon as possible to ensure transportation is in place for the first day of school. All transportation forms (Alternate Destination, Joint Custody, School of Choice) expire at the end of the 2025–2026 school year and must be resubmitted annually. Forms are available on the district website under transportation (<https://www.hartlandschools.us/Departments/Transportation/Forms/index.html>). Without new forms, default assignments apply. The deadline to request transportation other than the home address is June 15, 2026. Late requests will not be processed until after the first two weeks of school, which may leave your student without transportation.
