Curr & Instr **D.** **Adoption of Amplify Desmos Math for Grades TK-12** Action
 The adoption committee—comprised of teachers and administrators—evaluated materials based on district priorities and comprehensive student survey feedback. The selection was driven by four key pillars: 1) Instructional Rigor: Focuses on "Building Thinking Classrooms" through real-world tasks, explicit collaboration, and vertical non-permanent work surfaces. 2) Student Support: Includes robust EL resources, Special Education accessibility, and integrated manipulatives. 3) Standards Alignment: Features clear block-schedule pacing and explicit call-outs for Standards for Math Practices. 4) Assessment & Data: Provides multiple testing modalities with direct connections to Smarter Balanced Assessments. Implementation will follow a two-phase rollout:
 * 2026–2027: Grades 7–12
 * 2027–2028: Grades TK–6
 The program offers easy onboarding and ongoing professional learning to ensure instructional success. Upon approval, the District will finalize the teacher training schedule.

Facilities & Oper. **E.** **Contract with Diablo Roofing, Inc. and CJUSD for the North Country ES Classroom Roofing Project #26-05** Action
 The scope of work for this project includes the comprehensive re-roofing of seven (7) main classroom buildings – Cypress, Maple, Oak, Pine, Sequoia, Teachers Room, and Willow, as well as the Administration Building at North Country. Services include the removal and replacement of existing roofing system(s) and insulation board, installation of new gutters, downspouts, flashings, copings, and front fascia wrapped in sheet metal trim to ensure a complete finished roof system.
