# Grading Periods

- **Progress report grades** - indicator in the middle of the quarter as to how the student has been doing and being aware that there is still time for improvement
- **Quarter grades** - students have earned an official grade and depending on the teacher the grade will continue for next quarter or teachers will start fresh with grades
- **Semester grades** - teachers either combine the quarter grades or will grade based on their overall performance

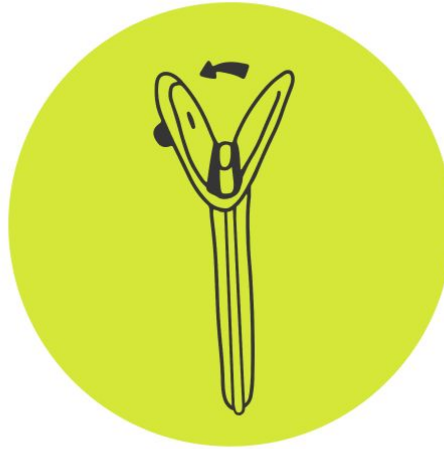




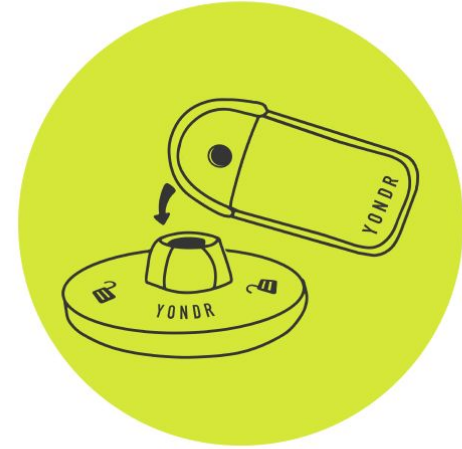
# Yondr Pouches

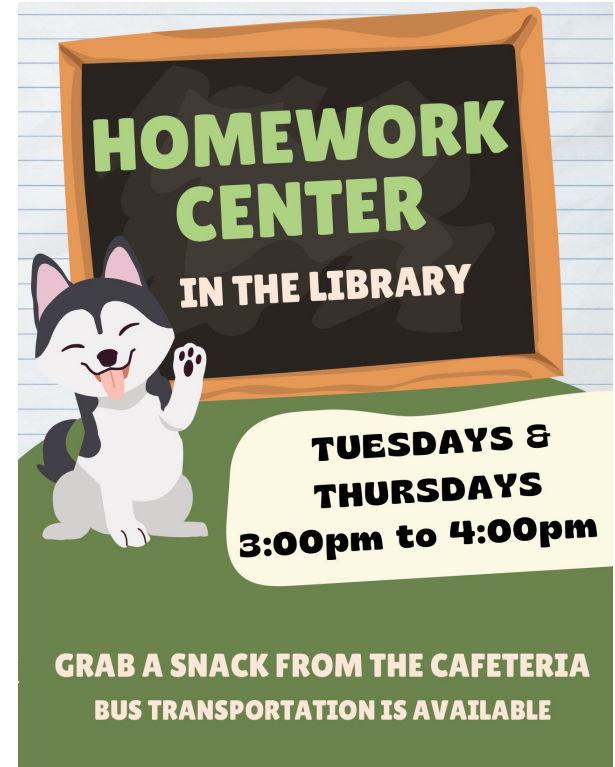
