Footwear: students are required to wear close-toed shoes. Shoes may not have any red or blue. Black, white, and grey prefered





Grading Periods

- **Progress report grades** indicator in the middle of the quarter as to how the student has been doing and being aware that there is still time for improvement
- **Quarter grades** students have earned an official grade and depending on the teacher the grade will continue for next quarter or teachers will start fresh with grades
- **Semester grades** teachers either combine the quarter grades or will grade based on their overall performance







Students close and secure their Pouch, keeping it on them throughout the day.




When leaving school, students tap their Pouch on a Base to retrieve their phone.


