- 1. Meeting called to order by Dianna 11:38am, quorum met
- 2. An additional committee member has been exposed to the public in the past week and has received threats and cyberbullying on Instagram and X. That makes a total of 4 members who have been harassed by the public since September.
- 3. Committee reviewed notes from 11/3/23 CHaSE meeting.
  - a. Clarify decision on slide 70 that the words above the chart will be removed but the chart will remain.
  - b. Committee voted unanimously to approve the notes as amended.
- 4. Committee reviewed notes from 11/5/2023 CHaSE meeting.
  - a. Clarify the addition of the teacher note on slide 95 regarding Hannah's statement about condom use.
  - b. Committee voted unanimously to approve the notes as amended.
- 5. Work on slide deck for SHAC presentation
  - a. General information and background information same as 6<sup>th</sup> grade presentation
  - b. Include a statement about things we discussed but didn't change. If there was no consensus AND no really strong opinions, the decision is to default to the publisher and the published materials.
  - c. Lesson 1 edits highlighted:
    - i. addition of group agreements.
  - d. Lesson 2 edits highlighted:
    - i. Slide 18: wording changed re: STD transmission definition. Approved wording is "through sexual contact including sexual skin-to-skin contact"
      - 1. A few members of the subcommittee feel it is important for this topic to be presented accurately to say that the original wording was problematic for some members of the subcommittee but not everyone; the decision has never been unanimous. The approved wording was suggested by CTB after members of the subcommittee asked for options to soften the original wording of "vaginal, oral, and anal sex." and the final vote was not a unanimous decision.
      - 2. The current wording is a concession for several members of the subcommittee but everyone agrees that we are here with the common goal to get this in classrooms in the spring. Concern was voiced that the full SHAC will get sidelined by this debate as well, and that will delay presenting to the Board of Trustees, so we need the discussion to focus on the compromise made in the subcommittee.
