- District and site admin conducted an evaluation of restroom facilities at CK Price. Current restroom partitions in student restrooms will be replaced with taller partitions to enhance privacy. The investment will be supported with Medi-Cal LEA BOP funding.
- The District is planning a high impact antibully campaign which will include antibullying assemblies in the Fall and Spring.
