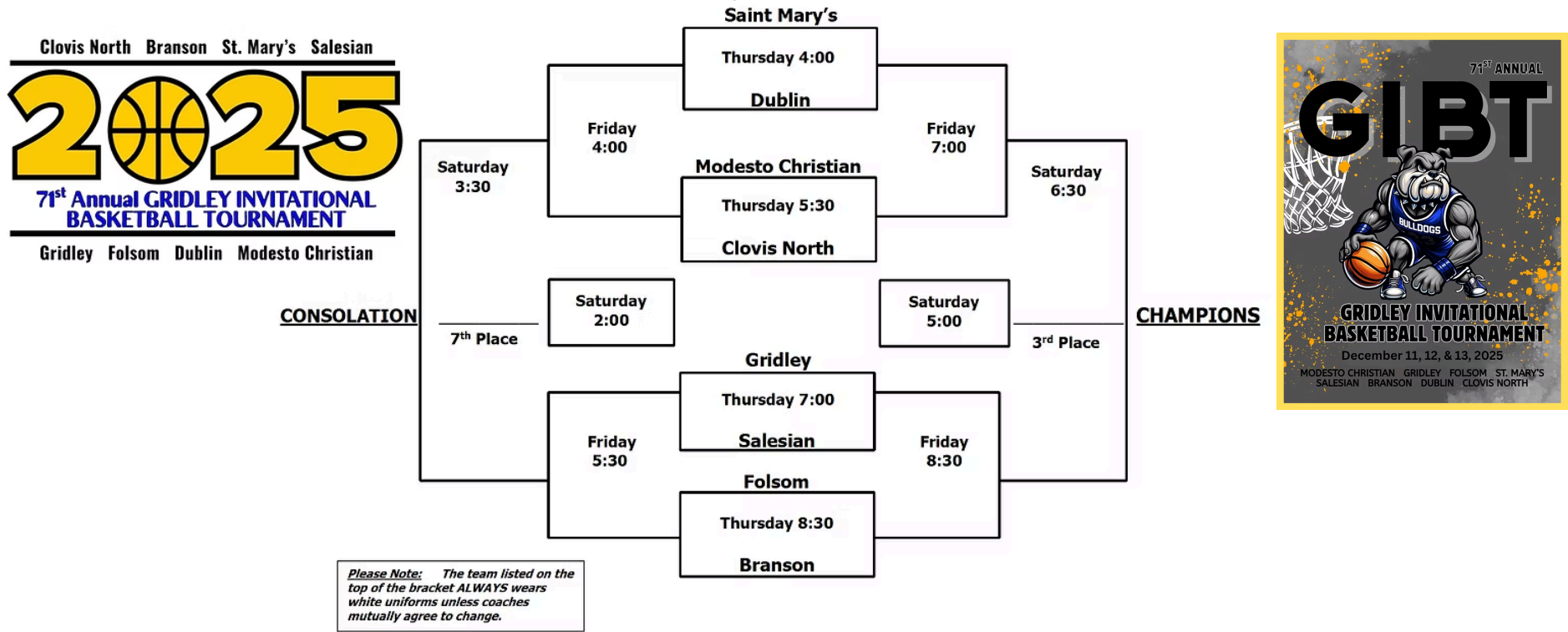




GIBT This Weekend

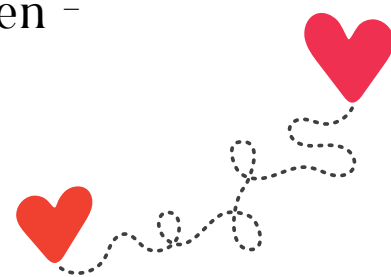


Guys and Dolls
