

SENSORY ACTIVITY

Hot Chocolate Slime

- 4 ounces of Elmer's White School Glue
- 1/2 Tbsp. of baking soda
- 1 Tbsp. of contact solution
- 1 Tsp. unsweetened cocoa powder (remember that this slime is NOT EDIBLE)
