

COMMUNITY RELATIONS:  
NONSCHOOL USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

GKD (R)

Board Policy GKD (LOCAL) provides the procedures for public use of school facilities.

Regulation GKD (EXHIBIT) provides local rules for campaign signage on District property when facilities are used as polling locations during an election.

LOCATION

Signs may be erected only at district/school facilities designated as polling locations for Early Voting and/or Election Day.

Signs may be erected only within the designated area at the district/school facility.

DURATION

Signs may be erected only one day prior to an Early Voting period if the district/school facility is designated as an Early Voting polling location.

Signs may be erected only one day prior to an Election Day if the district/school facility is designated as an Election Day polling location.

All signs must be removed within 24 hours of the termination of the voting period.

Signs may remain in place between the end of the Early Voting period and Election Day only if the district/school facility is both an Early Voting and Election Day polling location.

In the event of a runoff election, all signs should be removed for the interim period between elections.

SIZE AND QUANTITY

Signs may not be larger than 48" wide and 24" tall.

Signs may not be affixed to a stake taller than 36".

Three single signs per measure or candidate may be erected.

REMOVAL

Signs in violation of these regulations will be removed and discarded at the discretion of the district/school leadership.
