- 8. Plan ahead The gate to the parking lot closes at 9:30 am.
- 9. A Woodside High School is a **CLOSED CAMPUS**. No in and out privileges in the parking lot.
- 10. Do not share/distribute copies of your parking permit, doing so will result in the permit being revoked.
- 11. Citation examples include but are not limited to: permit not visibly displayed-parking in two spaces-blocked driveway or access-parked in no parking space-excessive speed. **\$30.00 fine.**
 - Driving a motor vehicle on the school grounds is a privilege granted by the Board of Trustees and rules/regulations are to be followed. Violators of the rules/regulations are subject to citations, disciplinary action, and/or loss of the privilege to drive a motor vehicle on the WHS campus.
 - Under Vehicular Code 2113(B): In order to maintain student health, safety, and general welfare, and
 to preserve a sound educational environment, all motor vehicles registered to park on the Woodside
 High School campus are subject to search and seizure of contraband, based upon reasonable
 suspicion without a judicial warrant.
