- The faculty and staff at WCHS are excited to begin the new school year with the implementation of an innovative schedule designed to better meet the academic and social emotional needs of our students. During the staff meeting on Wednesday, the team will review the new schedule, implementation procedures, and expectations to ensure a consistent and successful start to the year. We anticipate welcoming approximately 10 students on the first day of school, with enrollment expected to increase steadily over the coming weeks as student referrals and placements continue.
- The WCHS lunch room received a significant makeover this summer and now serves a dual purpose as both the student lunch area and the school's Wellness Room. The updated space provides students with a welcoming environment during lunch while also offering a designated area where they can access social emotional support with Kaitlynn Swihart, practice self regulation strategies, and take a brief, structured break when appropriate. The room is intended to help students develop coping skills, de-escalate emotions, and return to class ready to learn, supporting both student well being and a positive school climate.
