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**Course Goals:**

- Develop a strong understanding of linear equations, functions, and inequalities.
- Introduce basic geometric principles and proofs.
- Provide a foundation in statistics and data analysis.

**Course Description:** Math Integrated 1 is a comprehensive course for Grade 9 students that covers key concepts in algebra, geometry, and statistics. The curriculum is aligned with the California Common Core Standards and is designed to prepare students for Math Integrated 2.

**Grading System:**

- **Participation and Classwork:** 20%

**Doing Their Work Policy:**

- **Expectation:** Assignments must be submitted on time. Late submissions will be penalized, with partial credit available for work submitted within one week after the due date.

**Classroom Responsibility:**

**No Cellphone Policy:**

- **Calculator Provision:** Calculators will be available for use during class, so there is no need for cellphone use for calculations.

**Binder/Notebook:**

**Homework:**

- Homework assignments will be posted on Google Classroom. Students must complete their homework as directed, but also write out complete solutions or proofs on separate sheets of paper.
