## BAND CAMP HERE WE COME!!!!!


Well it's that time of year again...BAND CAMP! This is both an exciting time, but also an anxious time. A lot of the following information (plus a whole lot more!) is contained in the LHSDMB & Band Camp Handbook, so this is just reminders and clarification.

#### **Check-In**

Check-In at Band Camp will begin at 1:00 PM, at Slippery Rock University (Building B, 101 Rock Pride Dr., Slippery Rock, PA 16057). There will be signs directing you to the correct location. Please don't arrive early and expect to be checked in. We will need to set things up and prepare the camp, so please be mindful of the time and please be patient. Check-In will involve Students arriving and being given their room numbers, lanyards, and key cards. As stated previously in rehearsals and the Handbook, we recommend that Students DO NOT bring expensive items with them. Also, if it is something that is not allowed, Parents will be taking it back with them after Check-In.



TRANSPORTATION HOME: The LHSDMB will be transported home from Band Camp via school buses through the generosity of the Lakeside Music Boosters. YOU DO NOT PICK THEM UP FROM SLIPPERY ROCK!!!!!

PERFORMANCE AND PICK-UP: The Parent Preview Performance will be at 3:00 PM, in Lakeside Stadium. The LHSDMB will perform Pre-Game and as much of the 1st Half-Time Show as we get done at Band Camp. Students WILL BE excused AFTER the performance, so please, please, PLEASE DO NOT come over to the Band Room and try to meet them before the performance.

### ADDITIONAL LHSDMB25 BAND CAMP CONSIDERATIONS

- Students are permitted to bring bottled water, clear liquids, and small snacks. No meat or dairy products or any other perishable items are permitted in the rooms.
- Bringing snack items is a privilege not a right. If your room is not kept clean, we reserve the right to box up your food and return it to you at the end of the week.
- The Student Dorm does have vending machines where Students can buy pop, chips, cookies and candy BUT they may not be currently stocked.
- Slippery Rock University and Lakeside High School are not responsible for the damage, loss, or theft of any valuable or other items you choose to bring.
- The rooms are our responsibility from the time of first inspection to last.
- Mr. Roth may perform Daily room inspections...BE PREPARED!
- No roller blades, No skate boards, No scooters!
- Be prepared to live out of your suitcase.
- Be in shape! There will be a lot of physical demands on you. If you've been spending a lot of time in air conditioning, start getting out. Also, Band Members, get your lips and fingers in shape!
- Be aware there will be off-limit areas. These areas will be outlined by Mr. Roth at our first meeting at camp at 2:30 PM. If you are for any reason found in an off-limit area, you will be sent home.
- Students will be under adult supervision at all times.
- Anyone who is found outside of their rooms after the time designated as lights out, will be sent home.
- You are representing our school and community, do so with pride and dignity!
- If a Student decides that they cannot physically participate in field rehearsal due to injury or fatigue, Mr. Roth reserves the right to exclude them from evening activities or physical activities during free time and may choose to send the Student home.
- Students are not allowed to leave camp.
- Family, friends, boyfriends, or girlfriends are not permitted to visit camp. The only exception to this are Senior Parents that would like to attend the Senior Bonfire Tuesday night. Contact DPR for info.

These rules and expectations will not be compromised for anyone. Students who cannot respect others or follow school rules will be sent home.
