Motion to Approve Allocation Amendment (2025-2026)

Tischel presented the final numbers for the updated allocations, which include a 2.3% cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) from the May revise. This is a slight decrease from the previously anticipated 2.43% COLA.

These are the final numbers, and no further adjustments are needed. They were reviewed in preparation for a vote to approve the amendment at today's August meeting.

A motion to bring the Allocation Amendment for 2025-2026 to a vote was moved by Veronica Valenzuela and seconded by Miguel Hurtado.

2024-25 Consortium Carryover Projections

- Required to annually spend 80% of the current year's allocation as a consortium.
- If out of compliance 1st year, a written expenditure plan is required for the following year (24-25).
- If out of compliance two consecutive years (starting 2023-24), then additional measures may and can be made (including the reallocation of funds to other members of the consortium).
- o Through Q4, spent almost 800K over our estimates
