Volunteer and Bus Driver Certification

All RMSEL volunteers must go through a background screening that includes fingerprint processing through the CBI and FBI. Fingerprinting only has to be done one time; it does not have to be renewed annually. You may access the Volunteer Packet at this Link on our website. Bus driver certification is required before volunteers may drive RMSEL vehicles for trips. Bus Certification lasts for three years. Information for getting bus driver certification is included in the volunteer packet.

To complete your volunteer packet:

- Submit your fingerprint / background check
- Complete the volunteer packet paperwork

To be bus certified you must also complete these steps.

- Take the online bus driving tests
- Sign up for the road test

October Count

Each year, all public school districts across the state of Colorado participate in the Student October Count data submission to the Colorado Department of Education(CDE). The purpose of this data collection is to obtain required student level data as provided by the state statute. The October Count is the official student headcount for all Colorado public school districts that determines per pupil funding from the state. It is important to note that this data will impact the funding that RMSEL will receive. It is imperative that students attend school from September 24, 2025, through October 8, 2025. It is critical that we have all students in attendance on these days, especially on October 1, 2025, which is the official count date.
