UC & CSU College Application Helpful Hints:



- Franklin High School is a **SEMESTER** grading type system for completing college applications.
- Only A-G courses will be included on UC and CSU applications. Minis are not included.
- **If applying to a CSU**, launch through www.californiacolleges.edu. Once you connect to your CaliforniaColleges.edu account, your courses will be pre-populated for you. **DO NOT** manually type in your courses or grades.
- **If applying to a UC**, launch through www.californiacolleges.edu. You may import your academic history using your STATE STUDENT ID NUMBER, which can be found on your transcript. This will pre-populate your courses through the fall of junior year. You will need to manually type in your courses and grades for the spring of junior year. Senior courses also need to be recorded.
 - In Progress = A-G classes you are currently taking (Quarter 1 or 2)
 - Planned = A-G classes you will be taking (Quarter 3 or 4)

- On the UC application only, there is an opportunity for you to list some non A-G courses on the application. (Ex: STEAM coursework, Leadership, Link Crew, etc.)
