1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

In alignment with the goals of Proposition 28, Arts and Music in Schools, Lancaster School District allocated state funding to enhance and expand arts education across its school sites during the 2024–25 academic year. This strategic investment supported both student development and instructional capacity in arts and music. The district prioritized the expansion of elementary music instruction by funding six full-time music educator positions. These positions were distributed across the district to ensure equitable access to quality music education for over 7,000 students. Additionally, a full-time art teacher position was created at the middle school level. Using these funds, performing arts expanded to 13 schools, greatly increasing student access to arts and music instruction and thus boosting skills, creativity, and engagement. The Lancaster School District is committed to educating and inspiring the whole child. As such, the district will continue to support, grow and improve comprehensive arts education as an essential component of a well-rounded curriculum.
