TOP WAYS TO HELP SOMEONE WHO MAY BE STRUGGLING FROM AFSP & SEIZE THE AWKWARD

1. LEARN THE SIGNS

You might not be sure your friend is displaying concerning signs regarding their mental health. **Here are a few signs to look for**:

- Impulsive behaviors or being more irritated than usual
- Changes in habits of how they dress, appearance, eating, or sleep
- Talking about feelings of loneliness or despair
- Excessive worry or trouble concentrating
- Substance misuse

2. START THE CONVERSATION

Say whatever gets you talking, use an opening line like "Seems like something is up; do you want to talk about it? or "I've noticed you've been down lately. What's going on?"

Find time to talk; can be over lunch, shared hobby or sport, short walk or started with a "What's up"

3. DURING THE CONVERSATION

Being a friend and a good listener doesn't require a manual - there is no right or wrong. Just listening and letting them know you support them and they are not alone is a solid place to start. Be sure to ask about trusted adults they can talk to and support them by connecting directly with them.

4. AFTER THE CONVERSATION

After the conversation, continue to reach out and listen to them. Encourage their progress and connections with adults- and talk about your trusted adults on campus.




