Dear Seniors, Senior Parents and/or Guardians:

First of all, congratulations on reaching this point in your educational career! Enterprise High School will hold our graduation ceremony on Friday, June 5, 2026 at 8:00 pm. We are so proud of you all for this accomplishment and want to celebrate your achievement with a professional and dignified ceremony. We are expecting the Class of 2026 to conduct itself with dignity, and are asking for your support in this endeavor. We ask that everyone in attendance during the graduation ceremony proudly support these efforts with appropriate behavior and comments. Please do not distract from the ceremony by engaging in rowdy and disruptive behavior. This accomplishment is important to all graduates and their families, and our hope is that all graduates receive the same opportunity for recognition.

This is the graduation contract.

Please complete the contract and submit it to Ms. Wagner in the Main Office by Friday, May 8, 2026.

All seniors are required to complete a checkout form the week of finals. Once the checkout form has been completed and turned in to their counselor; the counselor will issue the graduate their twelve (12) graduation tickets. The checkout form will be issued to students on Tuesday, June 2nd.

The following guidelines concerning graduation dress code and conduct have been established for the benefit of all graduates to ensure a smooth-running, dignified ceremony that parents and relatives will enjoy:

1. The grad ceremony is a formal event. As such, we recommend business casual attire. Graduates may not wear pajama pants, jeans, slippers, or crocs. *It's highly advised that you wear the shoes you will wear to graduation to rehearsal, so you can practice walking in them on the field.*
2. There may be NO decorations on the caps or gowns, with the exception of recognized objects of religious or cultural significance. Leis are limited to one per graduate. Graduates check in at the North Gym at 6:45pm. Please check with admin BEFORE graduation if you have questions about the dress code.
3. Rehearsal will be held on June 5 at 8:00 am. All seniors are expected to be present at rehearsal. The graduates will sit in the order established during this rehearsal.

4. Graduation is a school activity, so all students must adhere to the same school rules as during a normal school day. There will be zero tolerance for drug or alcohol use, and any prospective graduate found “under the influence” will be removed from the ceremony immediately.
5. Choose your walking partner wisely, as this decision is final and cannot be changed once submitted.
6. Any graduate who disrupts the ceremony (with balloons, cell phones, noisemakers, toys or any other inappropriate item) may be removed immediately, and may pick up his/her diploma the following week.
7. Diplomas will be distributed after the graduation ceremony. Graduates will be informed where to pick up their diplomas during rehearsal. Any student who is completing credits through Independent Study, Adult Ed, Shasta College, American School or BYU will receive his or her diploma upon verification of completion of these credits.

ALL graduation requirements must be met prior to the ceremony in order for students to “walk the stage.”

As a convenience to you, EHS Yearbook will take photos at graduation. They will be posted on our Facebook page after graduation. The ceremony will also be livestreamed. The livestream will be available on our school website under the announcements section.

The faculty and students of Enterprise High School invite and welcome you to join us for this grand event to be held the evening of Friday, June 5, 2026, at 8:00 p.m. at the Enterprise High School Community Stadium Field.
