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# Earning Your Diploma

## **To Earn Your Diploma You Must:**

- Complete a minimum of 220 credits, including the following subject requirements:
- Must pass English
- Must pass Government and Economics
- Must pass any subject requirements that have not yet been fulfilled

## **If a student does not complete the above requirements**

- Will need to attend summer school to complete requirements
- Will not receive their diploma until requirements are complete
- Will not participate in the graduation commencement ceremony

# Community College

## Benefits for attending a Community College

- Transfer programs to impacted Four Year Universities
  - Transfer Agreement Guarantee (TAG) program - guaranteed transfer to select UC campuses after two years
  - Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) program - guaranteed transfer to a CSU campus
- Associates Degree (AA) or Certificate Programs
- With the Promise Program, the first two years could include free tuition and books

## Counseling 100

- Spring class offered to seniors (not required)

  - Promise Program Information

- Students receive both college and high school credit for the course.
- Meets once per week and counts as one of your 5 classes.

# Saddleback College

## College Promise Program

- Saddleback College promises to pay for the first two years of college for eligible full-time students or up to three years for eligible part-time students. Registration fees, support for book costs, health fee, and student involvement fees are included!
- Information will be shared in early October.
- Dedicated Saddleback Counselor on campus once per week
  - Wednesdays from 8:30-1:30

- Application Filing Window: Oct. 1 - Dec. 1
- **No Letters of Recommendation accepted**
- Application fee is \$80.00 per campus.
- Tesoro **CEEB Code 053-149**
- One application for all nine campuses.
- Students do **not** request transcripts for UC until after acceptance

# UC Acceptance

## Not Just GPA

- Minimum GPA required - 3.0 (UC weight standards)
- ELC - Top 9% of graduating class guaranteed acceptance into a UC school. Not always your first choice.
- **13 Factors are reviewed to determine acceptance** of applicants. Not all factors are within your control.  
Geography, Personal Hardship, Unique Circumstance

# UC Personal Insight Questions

## **Extremely important at competitive UC campuses**

- Respond to 4 of the 8 questions/prompts.
- Each response is limited to a of 350 words maximum.
- All questions have equal value.
- Students should select questions that are most relevant to them, to describe who you are, what matters to you, and what you will share with the UC.

# Applying to a CSU?

Launch CSU Application in [CaliforniaColleges.edu](https://CaliforniaColleges.edu)

- Application filing window: **Oct 1 - Dec. 1**
- Application fee is \$70.00 per campus.
- Tesoro **CEEB Code 053-149**
- One application for all 23 campuses.
- **NO Letters of Recommendation** or College Essay required
- Students do **not** request transcripts for CSU until after acceptance

# Applying to a Private/Independent University?

Tesoro High School **CEEB Code 053-149**

- Application Deadlines for private & out of state universities vary by institution.
- Over 1,000 colleges use CommonApp. For those not on the common app, go to university website to complete application.
- Complete application by specified deadlines; Often need to submit transcripts, scholarship info and financial aid with application.
- If required, contact College Board or ACT to have your SAT, AP, or ACT test scores sent to the campuses to which you've applied.

# Common App

- Generic application where you complete one application online for all colleges that are members.
- Check network to see if the private/independent universities you are applying to are members.

- When you create a profile on the common application, invite your School Counselor to complete their portion of the application.

# Official/Unofficial Transcripts

## Unofficial Transcripts

- Available via Student/Parent Portal
  - You will need a copy of your unofficial transcript to complete your application to CSU, UC, and private universities

## Official Transcripts

- Private/Independent Universities may require an official transcript as part of the application process. Available via [Parchment.com](https://parchment.com)
- Once you are accepted to and commit to a university (CSU, UC, or private) and graduate you will be prompted to send them your Official Final Transcript.
  - Official transcripts are only available via [PARCHMENT.](https://parchment.com)

# Letter of Recommendation

- Need a LOR from your School Counselor
  - Go to the Guidance tab and select “Guidance Quick Links”
    - “Letter of Recommendation Request”
      - at the bottom of the page
    - Nov or Dec application deadline - Request due by 10/10/25
    - Jan or later application deadline - Request due by 11/7/25
- Need a LOR from a teacher
  - Select a teacher that you feel knows you the best and can speak to who you are as a student.
  - Contact the teacher as early as possible.
  - Be sure to THANK them. Teachers write the letters on their own time.

# Financial Aid

**FAFSA** - (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) or CADAA

- In CA all students are expected to complete a financial aid application, regardless of income level, as it is required for many merit based scholarships.

**<https://fafsa.ed.gov>**

- Window to apply opens October 1st
- The sooner you submit your application better your chance for receiving aid.
- **Must create a FSA account before you can apply.**
- There is a student and a parent portion of the application.
  - Information from the **2024 Tax year** is needed.

# Scholarships

- As we receive scholarship information we post it on Guidance page of the school website under “College”.
- Students are responsible for applying to scholarships on their own.
- Adhere to deadlines and follow instructions for completing scholarship applications.
- Local scholarships (through PTSA, city organizations, employers) often have smaller pools.
- Apply to as many as you can. There are always scholarships that go unclaimed!
- Beware of scholarship scams - Don't pay someone who says they can get you a scholarship

# College Testing

ACT - Visit ACT.org to find local testing centers and to register.

SAT - Visit Collegeboard.org to find local testing centers and to register.

- Tesoro hosting SAT School day on Monday October 6th 2025.
- Register now.

Register EARLY! Spots fill up fast.

UC/CSU Do Not Use!

\*Testing is optional for most schools but required for some.

# Are Senior Classes Important?

**YES!!!**

- Your acceptance could be rescinded if:
  - You do not receive a "C" or better in all classes.
  - You drop a class that you reported as in progress on your application. Call your university before you drop or level in a class.
- End of the year awards that are determined using the 12 week progress report:
  - Scholar of Scholars
  - Valedictorian (GPA 4.0 +)
  - Academic Distinction (GPA 3.5 - 3.99)
