- Property Tax Bill Update: Property tax bills have begun going out, and you may notice an increase this year. This reflects the voter-approved *Measure U* bond, passed in 2024 with 66.85% support. All funds stay local and will be used to repair and modernize classrooms, enhance student safety, and build new learning spaces across Sierra Unified.
- Accountability and Transparency: Every dollar collected remains in our community and cannot be taken by the State. All projects are monitored through an independent Citizens' Oversight Committee and annual audits to ensure funds are spent exactly as voters intended.
