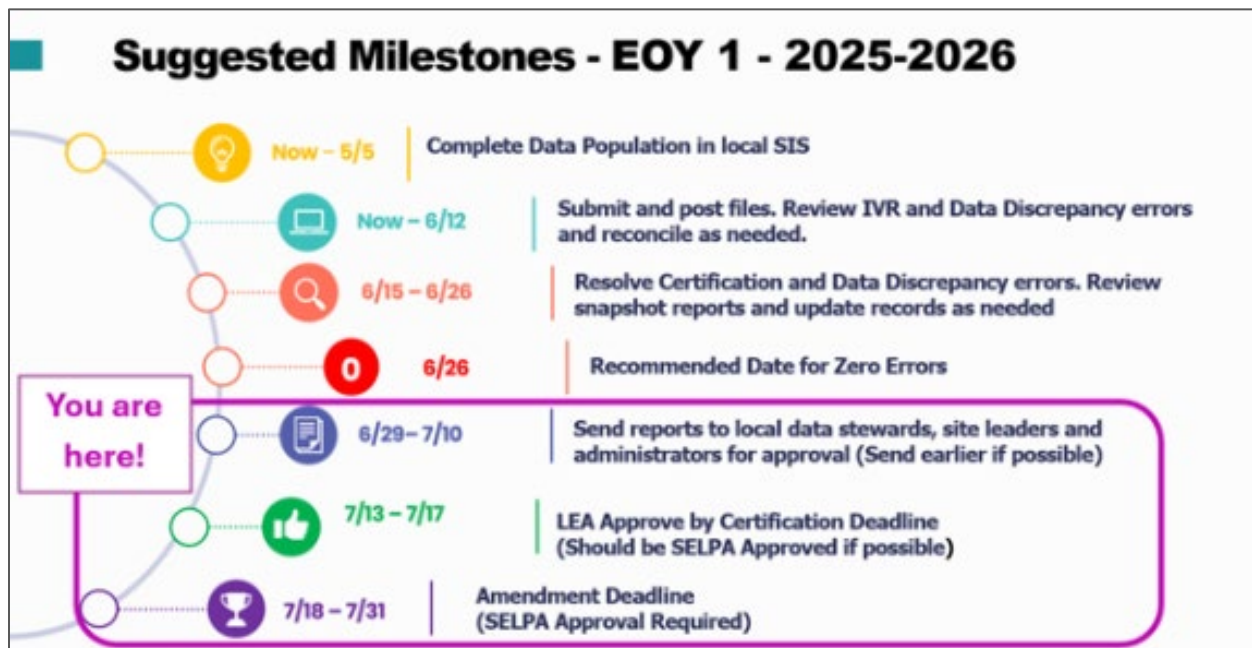
- Review your student's reporting LEA and school of attendance for accuracy
