I. Meeting Called to Order

Beverly Lebherz, new Chairperson, called the DEIC to order at 4:33 pm.

II. Approval of Minutes

III. District Scorecard

IV. Title 1 State and Compensatory Education Update

Dr. Munoz, Executive Director, Learning Support Services and Kellye Dear, Director, Federal Programs gave a PowerPoint presentation on Title 1 and State Compensatory Education. Ms. Dear began the presentation describing what Title 1 funds are and how they can be used. She also listed the Title 1 campuses in our district. Dr. Munoz explained what State Compensatory Education and how it is used. She explained the programs that are available to support students and help them reach their goals. At the end of the presentation the floor was opened for questions and discussion.

V. Looking Ahead

First Mr. Jarrett thanked all members for their participation in DEIC. He then discussed the District Scorecard and how important the members voice is to the District. He told members about an upcoming magnet program the district will be introducing in 2 years. The program will be call SETA (Space Engineering & Technologies Academy) and will work in conjunction with NASA. Students may enroll in SETA in 6th grade and continue the program through 12th grade. Next year will be a 1 to 1 device program for students. A grant was approved that will be used to purchase devices for each student. The floor was opened for discussion and questions were answered. Mr. Jarrett thanked everyone again and told them to enjoy their summer.
