Narrative Description of the Prop 28 Arts Education Program (s) funded in 2500 or less:** Oakland School for the Arts provides grade 6-12 students with intensive, industry aligned, specialized arts education across 10 pathways. The Prop 28 funds support OSA in providing salaries and benefits for our professional working artist educators in our Literary Arts, Production Design, Fashion Design, and Instrumental Music pathways. Students in these pathways receive 90-150 minutes of artistic training daily in addition to an entrepreneurial portfolio readiness offering ensuring that they are ready for both college and career upon graduation.
