

1. Considering the Additional Days School Year (ADSY) initiative, which offers funding for adding up to 30 instructional days for elementary schools under a 180-d...







Qualitative Feedback-Fall and Winter Breaks

Topic: Winter Break


Feedback:

- 10 school days of Winter break for teachers.
- Prefer Winter Break to begin closer to Christmas and return a few days after January 1.

Topic: 3-day weekend/Holiday Early Releases

Feedback:

- Consider early release days on the Fridays before Thanksgiving and Christmas break
- Add a Friday off per quarter or semester that is not a national holiday for travel w/o crowds
- Please help teacher morale by giving us a day off every month, like the students get!



Qualitative Feedback-Early Release Days

Topic: Consider providing afterschool tutoring or additional KINS program to help support working parents during early release days.

Feedback:

- Allow parents to use KIN on early release days. Very difficult to find childcare for working parents
- Be considerate of working parents who can not pick up their kids at 12:30. Thank you
- Early release does NOT help working parents at all. Please stop this every month.
- Afterschool tutoring should be considered for early dismissal days

Topic: Consider moving early release days to the end of the week as this helps working parents accommodate pick-up.


Feedback:

- Please put early release days on Fridays to help with daycare coverage.
- Early release days on Friday are much easier for lots of parents.
- Early release days on Fridays. We use vacation hours and then can't leave town or do anything mid-week

Topic: Consider combining early release days to allow for more full days off

Feedback:

- Removing half days and putting in just full days off for teachers. SCUC has done this works great.
- Half days do not add extra ease. No half days and just have full days off are better.
- Decrease early release days and condense into full days off. It's inconvenient to halt work.



Qualitative Feedback-Calendar

Topic: Consider aligning Spring Break and Other Holidays with surrounding districts as families may have students in different districts/colleges.


Feedback:

- As much as possible, align calendars with neighboring school districts.


Topic: Consider adding Non-Traditional Holidays to the calendar to account for high student absences during those dates.

Feedback:

- District holidays for high volume absence days, especially the day after Superbowl (Feb 10, 2025)
- Consideration of non-Christian holidays
- Days that we can account for increase in absences e.g. SuperBowl Sunday (Mon.), Easter Sunday (Mon)



Qualitative Feedback-Additional Information




Topic: Consider building in more planning days and PLC time, to allow for collaboration and help reduce the paperwork teachers have to do.


Which calendar option do you prefer?

Please select when you would prefer the school year to start and end.


End AFTER Memorial Day
16.7%




End BEFORE Memorial Day
