Course Goals:

- Gain proficiency in quadratic functions and equations.
- Explore advanced geometric concepts, including transformations and the properties of circles.
- Introduce students to basic trigonometric concepts.

Course Description: Math Integrated 2 continues to build on the concepts from Math Integrated 1, focusing on quadratic functions, advanced geometry, and introductory trigonometry. This course is aligned with the California Common Core Standards and prepares students for Math Integrated 3.

Doing Their Work Policy:

- **Expectation:** Students are responsible for completing all assignments on time. Late work will receive partial credit if submitted within one week of the due date.
