NEW Behavior Emergency Report Requirement

It has come to our attention via the California Department of Education, that LEAs must scan and attach a copy of each Behavioral Emergency Report, or BER, completed, to the student's current IEP in SEIS, or electronic IEP system in use.

This is very important for the Restraint and Seclusion monitoring process, should your LEA be required to participate.

At this time, LEAs should attach any BERs completed so far this school year, and each completed BER moving forward as regular practice.

Should you have any questions do not hesitate to reach out to your assigned Program Specialist.

Official Notification of 2025 Timeline Noncompliance

Due Date: October 24th

LEAs CEOs received Official CDE notification on Monday, August 25th that they remained noncompliant from the initial 2025 Certification deadline of December 12, 2024.

LEAs must complete the required student-level corrective actions and update the student's record in CALPADS by October 24, 2025.

If the LEA does not correct the noncompliance and update the student's record by the due date, the noncompliance will be considered overdue and will be a negative factor in the LEA's Annual Determination, slated for release February 2026.

Fall 1 Submission Window Opens on Census Day: October 1, 2025

As we approach Census Day, this is a reminder that CDE pulled Annual Determination Letter (ADL) Data on the initial LEA due date, so please ensure the following are completed:

- Affirm all meetings and amendments that are dated before October 1.
- Upload parent signatures and submit reportable transactions to CALPADS.
- Create a Correction amendment to update Degree of Support where applicable (CDE Guidance).

Key Dates

- Fall 1 Due to SELPA by December 5, 2025 to allow for SELPA review!
- CDE Fall 1 LEA Approval Deadline: December 12, 2025 (SELPA Approval Encouraged).
- Amendment Window: December 13, 2025 January 23, 2026
- January 23, 2026: LEA & SELPA Approval Due!

SEIS Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

The El Dorado County Charter SELPA is happy to announce that SEIS users can utilize the SMS/Text Validation at no additional cost to the LEA. The SELPA is in the process of activating this feature, and we will let you know when it's live!

- MFA is mandatory for all users starting Monday, September 29.
- Users will receive a verification code via email when logging in or districts can opt to receive codes via SMS (Text Message).
- Verify all SEIS account email addresses and cell phone numbers now!
- MFA setup materials available here.

We strongly recommend enabling MFA before the mandatory deadline to prevent any potential work stoppages leading into Fall 1, in case complications arise.



Meeting Alerts: SEIS Dashboard

Past Due Meetings

- Schedule and hold overdue meetings ASAP!
- Add correct meeting delay codes before affirming late meetings.
- If a meeting will be late, create a pending transaction and report it to CALPADS with a meeting delay code.
- Double-check for clerical errors (e.g., wrong dates or meeting types, compare with 16.21 report).

SEARCHES to Run Now for Fall 1 Accuracy

- Searches > SEIS Searches
 - o Program Setting (5-22)-PLAN0619F1/PLAN0389F1
 - Transition Goals and Services (high schools only)
- Searches > Shared Searches
 - o <80% in Gen Ed-SPP Indicator 5A
 - Code 900 Services
 - If a student is listed on this search, contact your SELPA Program Specialist for an alternative service code.
- Student is Eligible with Exit/Date Reason.

If any corrections are necessary, prepare amendments (dated on or before Census Day) to update and/or correct inaccurate program settings or general education percentages.

CALPADS Transactions for 2025-2026

You can now begin submitting reportable transactions to CALPADS! Be sure to review any DNR'd transactions, each must include a comment explaining the reason for the DNR.


Information Eligibility Page Update

New updates have been made to the Information Eligibility page. Please note that the 'Calculate Dates' buttons will only affect the currently selected meeting type:

INFORMATION/ELIGIBILITY

The Next Dates validation has been updated.

- If the Next Plan Review date is OVER 1 year, it will result in an error.
- If the Next Reevaluation date is OVER 3 years, it will result in an error.





UPDATES

Fall 1 Local SEDS Audit Checklist

- ✓ Affirm/Lock/Save all IEPs and Amendments
- ✓ Review any students or transactions marked "Do Not Report"
- ✓ Ensure case managers have exited any students who have exited special education.
- ✓ Ensure SSID and Local ID fields are populated
- ✓ Ensure Transition Indicators are populated for any student who will be 16 on Census Day (Y or N)
- ✓ Review the General Education Participation percentage ensure numbers are not transposed
- ✓ Ensure any student age 5 or higher who is enrolled in TK or higher is in a SCHOOL-AGE setting
- ✓ Submit pending MEET records with appropriate Meeting Delay Code for any Initial Evaluation, Annual Plan Review, or Triennial Evaluation that is overdue as of Census Day
- ✓ Review CALPADS District of Special Education Accountability (DSEA) Extracts to verify DSEA is correct
- ✓ Compare data between student information system (SIS) and the SEDS to ensure students are identified consistently in both systems (e.g. name, birth date, race/ethnicity)
