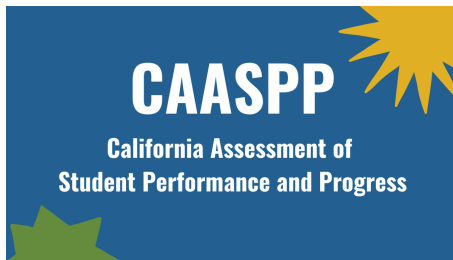

Notes From The Health Office

If your student has medication that is kept in the health office, arrangements need to be made to pick it up by the end of the school year. **Please have an adult pick up all medications by Thursday, June 4th as students are not allowed to carry home the medications.** You may either plan to pick up your student's medication on the last day of school, or count out ahead of time how much medication your child will need to get them through to the last day. Any medications left after the last day of school will be discarded. **Students requiring any medication administration at school for the 2026-27 school year will need to have new medical authorization forms filled out and signed by both the healthcare provider and**

the parent/guardian.

Health staff will be available on Monday, August 10th between 10-2

pm, at the EUSD District Office, to receive medication and forms for students. All medication forms are available on our EUSD Health Services page.

Bringing In Food Items

Also, as we near the close of the school year and celebrations will be happening (end of year parties, birthdays, etc.), we appreciate you speaking with your child's teacher first prior to dropping off any food items in the office. Our current food policy is the classroom teacher must know at least two weeks in advance to review the food for approval. Due to allergies, please do not drop off any food items to the office unless your classroom teacher has given you the permission first. After review, your child's teacher may ask that their student not bring the treat, bring in an alternate treat and/or include the treat ingredient label.
