**THE RED BLUFF UNION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BOARD DECLARES
AUGUST AS SCHOOL BULLYING PREVENTION MONTH:**

WHEREAS, bullying is unwanted, aggressive behavior among school aged children that involves a real or perceived power imbalance; and

WHEREAS, individuals of all ages, abilities, and backgrounds have the right to live without the fear of verbal, physical, and social bullying; and

WHEREAS, school bullying has become an increasingly significant and prevalent problem throughout California and the nation; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that more than twenty percent of California youth are involved in bullying each year, either as a victim or as an aggressor; and

WHEREAS, bullying can assume many forms, including verbal, physical, emotional, and cyber, and can happen both on and off school grounds; and

WHEREAS, it is important for district parents, students, teachers, and school administrators to be aware of and address bullying, and to encourage discussion as a school community; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has developed a model policy on anti-bullying to encourage positive behaviors and to eliminate bullying behaviors;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Red Bluff Union Elementary School Board, hereby proclaims August, as School Bullying Prevention Month.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be inserted in the minutes of the August meeting.
