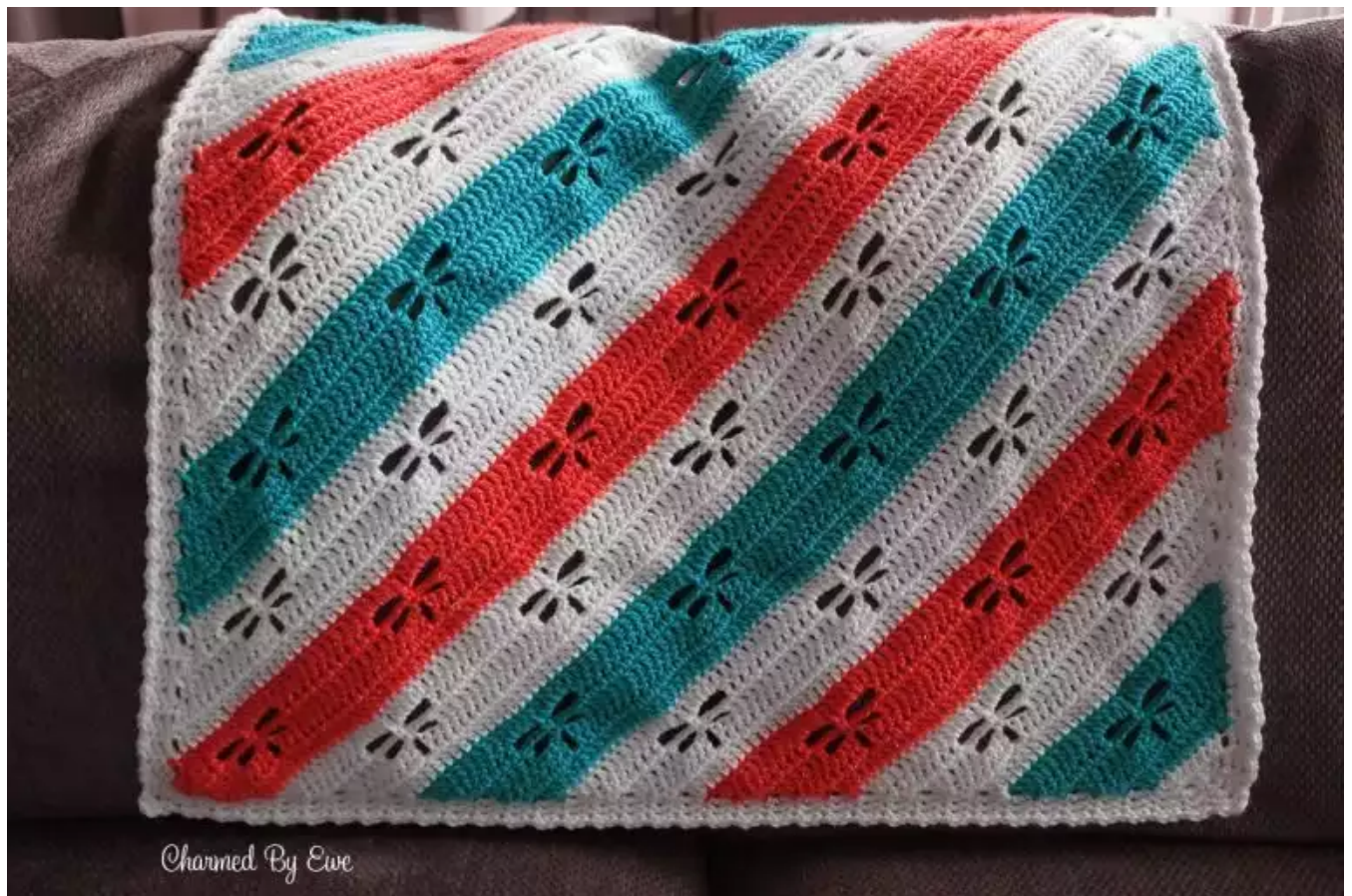

Free Crochet Pattern: Dragonfly C2C Throw

I received a special request from Lorri to turn the popular dragonfly stitch into a corner-to-corner blanket. I thought it would be a simple task, but getting the spacing right turned out to be quite a challenge. It was a fun challenge though, and I'm so pleased with final

result!

The sample blanket pictured above is smaller than what the written instructions will produce, so the total yardage listed below was estimated based on the yardage used for the sample blanket.

PIN It For Later

Skill Level: Intermediate

Size: Finished throw measures approximately 48 x 48 inches.

Supplies:

- Worsted weight yarn
 - A – [Red Heart Soft in White](#) (approx. 4 skeins)
 - B – [Red Heart Soft in Turquoise](#) (approx. 2 skeins)
 - C – [Red Heart Sparkle Soft in Coral](#) (approx. 2 skeins)
- [Size 5.0 mm \(H-8\) crochet hook](#) or size needed to obtain the gauge
- [Yarn needle](#) for weaving in ends

Gauge in DC: 14 stitches and 8 rows = 4" (10 cm)

Abbreviations: ch = chain, sk = skip, sl = slip, st(s) = stitch(es), sc = single crochet, dc = double crochet, dc2tog = double crochet 2 together, dc5tog = double crochet 5 together, trc = treble crochet, trc2tog = treble crochet 2 together

Special Instructions:

- The beginning chain of each row or round does not count as a stitch.
- Instructions between (), * or ** are to be repeated the specified number of times.
- Instructions between [] are all worked into the same stitch.

Split Stitch: Working a split stitch means that you will be working into the center “V” of the stitch below, not into the top loops.

Pattern Instructions

Section 1. Begin with Color A.

Row 1 (Right Side): Ch 4, in 4th ch from hook make [1 trc, 3 dc, 1 trc], turn. (5)

Row 2: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 3 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (9) – Fasten off.

Section 2. With Right Side facing, join Color B in the first stitch of the row.

Row 3: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 7 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (13)

Row 4: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 5 sts, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 5 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (16 sts + 1 ch-2 space)

Row 5: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 4 sts, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, skip next 3 sts, dc in next 4 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (15 sts + 2 ch-3 spaces)

Row 6: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 5 sts, ch 4, sk next dc and ch-3 space, work a split sc into the sc st from the previous row, ch 4, skip ch-3 space and next dc, dc in next 5 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (17 sts + 2 ch-4 spaces)

Row 7: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 7 sts, make 4 dc in the ch-4 space, work a dc into the center “v” of the sc below, make 4 dc in next ch-4 space, dc in next 7 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (29) – Fasten off.

Section 3. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 8: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in each st to end, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (33)

Row 9: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 5 sts, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 19 sts, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 5 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

Row 10: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 4 sts, (ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, skip next 3 sts), dc in next 13 sts, repeat between () 1 time, dc in next 4 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

Row 11: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 5 sts, (ch 4, sk next dc and ch-3 space, work a split sc into the sc st from the previous row, ch 4, skip ch-3 space and next dc), dc in next 11 sts, repeat between () 1 time, dc in next 5 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

Row 12: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 7 sts, (make 4 dc in the ch-4 space, work a dc into the center "v" of the sc below, make 4 dc in next ch-4 space), dc in next 11 sts, repeat between () 1 time, dc in next 7 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (49) – Fasten off.

Section 4. With Right Side facing, join Color C in the first stitch of the row.

Row 13: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in each st to end, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (53)

Row 14: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 5 sts, (ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 19 sts) 2 times, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 5 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

Row 15: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 4 sts, (*ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, skip next 3 sts*, dc in next 13 sts) 2 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 4 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

Row 16: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 5 sts, (*ch 4, sk next dc and ch-3 space, work a split sc into the sc st from the previous row, ch 4, skip ch-3 space and next dc*, dc in next 11 sts) 2 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 5 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

Row 17: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 7 sts, (*make 4 dc in the ch-4 space, work a dc into the center "v" of the sc below, make 4 dc in next ch-4 space*, dc in next 11 sts) 2 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 7 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (69) – Fasten off.

Section 5. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 18 to 22: Repeat Row 13 to 17. The instructions between () will be worked 3 times.

Section 6. With Right Side facing, join Color B in the first stitch of the row.

Row 23 to 27: Repeat Row 13 to 17. The instructions between () will be worked 4 times.

Section 7. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 28 to 32: Repeat Row 13 to 17. The instructions between () will be worked 5 times.

Section 8. With Right Side facing, join Color C in the first stitch of the row.

Row 33 to 37: Repeat Row 13 to 17. The instructions between () will be worked 6 times.

Section 9. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 38 to 42: Repeat Row 13 to 17. The instructions between () will be worked 7 times.

Section 10. With Right Side facing, join Color B in the first stitch of the row.

Row 43: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in each st to end, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn. (173)

Row 44: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 5 sts, (ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 19 sts) 8 times, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 5 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

Row 45: Ch 3, in first st make [1 trc + 2 dc], dc in next 4 sts, (*ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, skip next 3 sts*, dc in next 13 sts) 8 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 4 sts, in last st make [2 dc + 1 trc], turn.

DECREASING

Special Instructions:

At the beginning of each row: [trc+dc2tog]. Ch 3 to begin. In first stitch, work a treble crochet, but leave the last 2 loops on the hook. In next stitch, work a double crochet up to the last 2 loops. Yarn over and pull through all loops on the hook.

At the end of each row: [dc+trc2tog]. In second last stitch, work a double crochet, but leave the last 2 loops on the hook. In last stitch, work a treble crochet up to the last 2 loops. Yarn over and pull through all loops on the hook.

Row 46: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 2 sts, (*ch 4, sk next dc and ch-3 space,

work a split sc into the sc st from the previous row, ch 4, skip ch-3 space and next dc*, dc in next 11 sts) 8 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 47: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, (*make 4 dc in the ch-4 space, work a dc into the center "v" of the sc below, make 4 dc in next ch-4 space*, dc in next 9 sts) 8 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (173) – Fasten off.

Section 11. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 48: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in each st until 4 sts remain, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (169)

Row 49: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 10 sts, (ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 19 sts) 7 times, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 10 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 50: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 5 sts, (*ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, skip next 3 sts*, dc in next 13 sts) 7 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 51: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 2 sts, (*ch 4, sk next dc and ch-3 space, work a split sc into the sc st from the previous row, ch 4, skip ch-3 space and next dc*, dc in next 11 sts) 7 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 52: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, (*make 4 dc in the ch-4 space, work a dc into the center "v" of the sc below, make 4 dc in next ch-4 space*, dc in next 11 sts) 7 times, repeat between * 1 time, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (153) – Fasten off.

Section 12. With Right Side facing, join Color C in the first stitch of the row.

Row 53 to 57: Repeat Row 48 to 52. The instructions between () will be worked 6 times.

Section 13. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 58 to 62: Repeat Row 48 to 52. The instructions between () will be worked 5 times.

Section 14. With Right Side facing, join Color B in the first stitch of the row.

Row 63 to 67: Repeat Row 48 to 52. The instructions between () will be worked 4 times.

Section 15. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 68 to 72: Repeat Row 48 to 52. The instructions between () will be worked 3 times.

Section 16. With Right Side facing, join Color C in the first stitch of the row.

Row 73 to 77: Repeat Row 48 to 52. The instructions between () will be worked 2 times.

Section 17. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 78: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in each st until 4 sts remain, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (49)

Row 79: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 10 sts, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 19 sts, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 10 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 80: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 5 sts, *ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, skip next 3 sts*, dc in next 13 sts, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 81: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 2 sts, *ch 4, sk next dc and ch-3 space, work a split sc into the sc st from the previous row, ch 4, skip ch-3 space and next dc*, dc in next 11 sts, repeat between * 1 time, dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 82: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, *make 4 dc in the ch-4 space, work a dc into the center "v" of the sc below, make 4 dc in next ch-4 space*, dc in next 11 sts, repeat between * 1 time, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (33) – Fasten off.

Section 18. With Right Side facing, join Color B in the first stitch of the row.

Row 83: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in each st until 4 sts remain, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (29)

Row 84: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 10 sts, ch 2, sk next st, dc in next 10 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 85: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 5 sts, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in ch-2 space, ch 3, skip next 3 sts, dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 86: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 2 sts, ch 4, sk next dc and ch-3 space, work

a split sc into the sc st from the previous row, ch 4, skip ch-3 space and next dc, dc in next 2 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn.

Row 87: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, make 4 dc in the ch-4 space, work a dc into the center "v" of the sc below, make 4 dc in next ch-4 space, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (13) – Fasten off.

Section 19. With Right Side facing, join Color A in the first stitch of the row.

Row 88: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next 4 sts, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (9)

Row 89: Ch 3, [trc+dc2tog], dc2tog, dc in next st, dc2tog, [dc+trc2tog], turn. (5)

Row 90: Ch 3, decrease over the 5 remaining sts, (I worked a trc in the first and last st and dc in the 3 sts between, or you can work dc5tog), ch 1 to secure the stitch. (1)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Border

You will be working along the ends of the rows. With right side facing, join Color A by slip stitching around the beginning chain of Row 1.

Note: *The end stitch of the last increase row will become the "corner" stitch when working Round 1.*

Round 1: Ch 1, make 3 sc in same space, *make 3 sc in end of each row to next corner, make 5 sc in corner stitch*, repeat between *to end, sl st to join in first sc, do not turn.

Round 2: Sl st into next st to move starting position. Ch 1, make 3 sc in same st, (*sk 2 sts, make 3 sc in next st*, repeat between * to corner, sk 3 sts, make 5 sc in corner st, sk 3 sts, make 3 sc in next st), repeat between () to end, sl st to join in first sc.

For a wider border, repeat Round 2 as many times as preferred before working Round 3.



Round 3: Sl st into next st to move starting position. Ch 1, make 3 sc in same st, (*sk 2 sts, make 3 sc in next st*, repeat between * to corner, sk 3 sts, in corner stitch make [2 sc, 3 hdc, 2 sc], sk 3 sts, make 3 sc in next st), repeat between () to end, sl st to join in first sc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.
