

2026 –2027 SBRHS Student Drop-Off and Pickup Traffic Pattern

To limit the backup of traffic on Luther Avenue, County Street, and other places, the following student drop-off and pickup pattern will be used again for the 2026-2027 school year. Just like last year, the following will be the drop-off and pickup pattern:

The Luther Avenue Entrance to Blue Raider Boulevard will be closed to vehicles entering for student drop-off from 7:00 AM to 7:30 AM. To drop students off on campus, you must enter the campus for drop-off from the County Street/Grandview Avenue entrance or the Clifford Holland entrance (refer to red arrows in the image below).

The southbound lane (closest to the building) of Blue Raider Boulevard will remain closed to all traffic during this time (7:00 AM-7:30 AM) except for SBRHS/Fisher Bus special education vans.

When picking up your child in the afternoon, it is also highly recommended that you enter onto campus using the County Street/Grandview Avenue or Clifford Holland entrance and stage in the northbound travel lane of Blue Raider Boulevard for your child to exit the building.

All parent traffic exiting onto Luther Avenue from Blue Raider Boulevard is right turn only (East) to County Street to limit vehicular traffic in the pedestrian crossing area on Luther Avenue.

The North Side of Luther Avenue is posted with no parking or standing signs, and the Somerset Police Department will enforce this during drop-off and pick-up times.

Parents should not be entering the staff or student parking lots to drop off their children as this causes parking and safety issues for students and staff arriving to school.
