Behavior & Discipline

- Establish a robust anti-bullying intervention system.
- Help students understand the impact of their actions and reinforce expectations that support a safe and respectful culture.
- Proactively address behavioral concerns to foster a positive and focused learning environment for all students.

Mental Health & Character

- Teach students empathy and character with strategies to support mental well-being and restore relationships.
- Address bullying by understanding causes of student behavior and offering support.
- Provide individual and small group services to help students navigate emotional and behavioral challenges.

Academic support

- Strengthen support for students who need additional help through programs such as WIN and EL small group.
- Provide targeted 1:1 and small group instruction to build academic skills and confidence.
- Prioritize reading interventions to ensure all students develop strong, grade-level reading proficiency.

Recognition and Celebrations

- Increase opportunities to celebrate and recognize positive student behavior.
- Foster a school culture that promotes positivity, academics, and respectful conduct.
- Maintain and enhance recognition programs such as Trimester awards, Attendance, and Student of the Week.

Parent Involvement

- Promote greater parent involvement in school events and activities.
- Provide meaningful opportunities for families to volunteer and engage in their child's learning experience.
- Strengthen communication between teachers and families to keep them informed and connected to student progress and school happenings.

Hagginwood - Academic Actions

SST: Hire an EL SST & SST to work with EL pull-out during WIN

ELD: Continue PD on integrated and designated strategies.

ELA: Continue Lesson Design (4-6) and CORE (K-3) early literacy strategies. Focus on increasing writing.

Math: Build routines that facilitate student dialogue and modeling.

<u>Testing:</u> Build rigor and stamina through integrated testing strategies.
