Thank you for your ongoing partnership and commitment to our schools. Spring reminds us that growth happens in so many ways—academically, socially, and as a community. Together, we are preparing every student for a bright and successful future.

Around the District

We are excited to offer families an alternative option to receive the required vaccinations at a more convenient location. The Fresno County Immunization Mobile Clinic will be on site at Foothill Elementary, on May 27th and at Sierra Jr. & Sr. High, on May 29th. To take advantage of this convenient service, parents will need to accompany their students. In addition, Sierra Jr. & Sr. High will also be hosting a FREE Sports Physical Clinic for prospective 2025-26 student athletes, which will be held on August 15th. Just a reminder that California does require some vaccinations for students to attend any school in California. Please take advantage of this opportunity to make sure your child may attend school on the first day. This includes 6th grade students moving to 7th in need of their TDAP.
