JOB TITLE: CAMPUS AIDE

**RESPONSIBLE TO**: Site Principal

## **General Summary:**

Under the supervision of the school site principal and/or designated administrator, within the standard policies and procedures, patrol school grounds, parking lots and building areas to maintain order, security and safety of all school employees, students and property; promotes positive behavior of students and visitors on the campus.

#### **Performance Responsibilities:**

- Supervise students on school grounds and in other areas of the campus outside the classrooms;
- Prevent unruly conduct by students on campus grounds;
- Be watchful for safety violations and correct as observed;
- Enforce rules firmly and fairly;
- Assess a situation, make a proper decision, and take the appropriate action;
- Perform related duties as assigned

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

## Knowledge of:

- Knowledge of school rules and regulations.
- Knowledge of social and personal needs of school age children.

# Ability to:.

- Communicate effectively, both verbally and in written form, with a wide variety of people in diverse age groups;
- Deal tactfully, and effectively with students, teachers, other staff members and the public;
- Supervise students to ensure appropriate behavior, deal effectively with inappropriate behavior;
- Follow written and oral instructions;
- Answer questions and make referrals to the proper administrator.

# Education and Experience:

• Any combination equivalent to sufficient experience, training, and/or education to demonstrate the knowledge's and abilities listed above.

## Licenses and other requirements:

A valid California Driver's License.

#### Physical Characteristics:

- Requires the ability to hear at close proximity (up to five feet) and at a distance (up to twenty feet); clarity of vision at varying distances; and
- Requires the ability to stand and walk for long periods of time.

### Working Conditions:

- Exposure to volatile situations involving students and/or parents; and
- Work involves indoor and outdoor environment; and exposure to extreme heat and cold; and
- Occasional exposure to blood-borne pathogens and body fluids from injured or ill students.
